 - 2.2. Encourage engagement with the details of the proposals
 - 2.3. Gather responses and feed those back to the Planning Dept


The consultation ran from 21 December 2018 to 27 January 2017





Leaflets were printed early January, with distribution between 11 and 16 January.


Recipients could engage online or attend the drop-in event in the Library, and/or contact the Planning Dept with queries.

A total of 269 individual responses were received during the period with percentages as follows.








How do you rate the traffic and parking proposals?
