It is part of our local heritage- the pool was there (which I used as a child) and now the pitz and tumbles mean a whole new generation are engaging in physical activity with all the health benefits that brings. What I have seen for my son growing up in porty is that the pitz provides a unique place where young lads (usually blamed for a raft of social problems) can easily arrange to meet to kick a ball about for an hour or two. It is a welcoming environment for them, they dont need adults to arrange it for them. It is a 'cool' place to go and as a young teenager he spent a lot of time there. I cannot imagine any other place in portobello where he would have done this- it was so easy to arrange. Older men also meet there- some of my neighbours meet for 7 a side- men have so few places outside pubs to meet without pressure to drink, or other activities men are expected to take part in. The pitz is a precious place for these kind of interactions to take place. I am not saying this is only for men but I think the pitz is a very special space in the local community. We CERTAINLY do not need more commercial/housing/business developments in Portobello. We need to make sure there is space for community, for engagement, for activity. I havent written about tumbles- I was very sad the bowling went from that building, but tumbles is really busy and again getting loads of kids involved in physical activity. Some small commercial would be welcome especially a doctor's surgery or live/work units along with some community facilities. There should certainly not be another supermarket on the site. Tumbles may be relocated to free up more valuable land for development on the promenade however the frontage of the site to the promenade that is currently the car park should form the northern boundary of a new park providing more open space in this part of the town which currently suffers a deficit. The Figgate Bum should be incorporated into this new link between the High Street and the Promenade. It is essential that the open view to Arthur's Seat remains. Should the loss of capital receipt be such that there is a shortfall then the agreement with Powerleague should be renegotiated in favour of the council rather than reward a tenant which has sought to get out of the long term lease for well over ten years. An alternative is to sell part of the site of the old high school and allocate some of the open space lost by building the school on Portobello Park to an area of Portobello rather than increasing the amount of quality parkland adjacent to Figgate Park. All of the above comments assume that the council will go ahead with some form of disposal rather than accept that there may be other ways of raising the finance for Meadowbank.	EH151Lx
