Please see below for a brief history for the street;
Johnny Cunningham, born in Portobello in 1957, was a folk musician widely considered responsible for spreading interest in traditional Celtic music around Europe and America as a member of the band Silly Wizard (amongst others).

The Council have provisionally given the following name(s) to the street(s):-
Adamslaw Place

Please see below for a brief history for the street;
Adam's Law is a historic name for the land the development is being built on, as seen on a plan of Portobello from 1783 (copy attached). It was the source of the clay used in the brickworks located on the site.

The Council have provisionally given the following name(s) to the street(s):-
Barnie Terrace

Please see below for a brief history for the street;
Dr William Edward "Ned" Barnie was a Portobello resident and the first person to swim the English Channel three times. He was a science teacher at a number of Edinburgh schools throughout his career, including St Anthony's and David Kilpatrick's Schools. A commemorative plaque was erected in 2006 at 7 Straiton Place, where he lived for many years.
